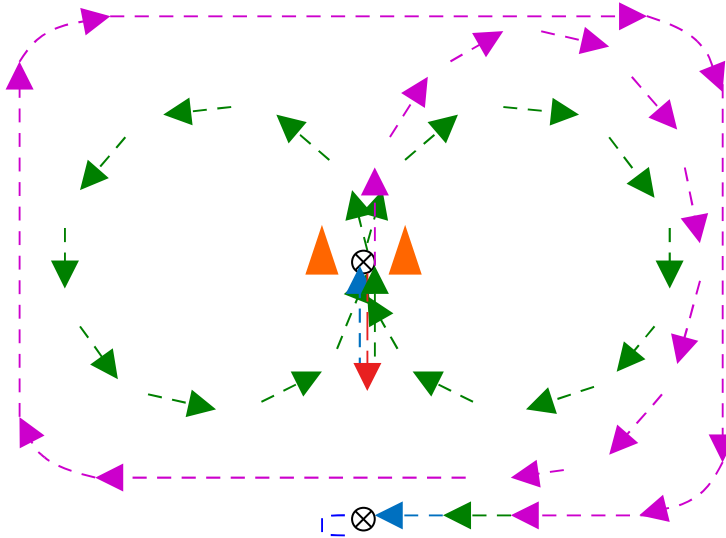


Mule Open Ridden Patterns 2009

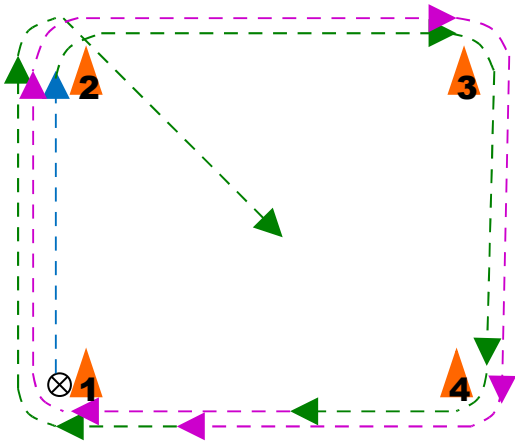
1. The patterns will be judged on style, accuracy and willingness
2. The show schedule will nominate a pattern to be used for the Class. If the schedule does not give this information the judge will chose one.
3. The pattern may be called for the competitor.

'Figure 8a' Pattern

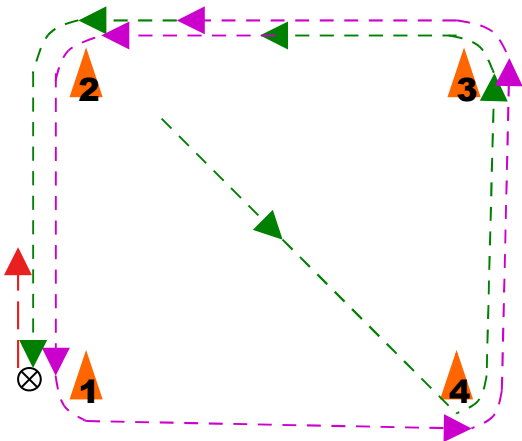


1. Walk to cones Halting between the cones
2. Proceed to Trot a 'Figure 8' (cones marking central point)
3. Halt 4 seconds (shoulder of animal in line with cones)
4. Reverse 5 strides
5. Continue forward between the cones and into Canter around the outside of the ring
6. As coming along the bottom of the ring the second time, come back to a Halt
7. Complete a 180° Turn around the Forehand

Square Pattern



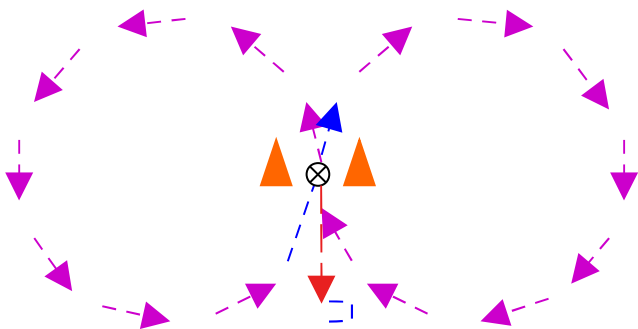
1. Halt at Cone 1. Proceed at Walk
2. At Cone 2 Trot. Proceed around Cones 3 & 4
3. Approaching Cone 1 Canter right and proceed around outside of the cones at a Canter.
4. As coming back to Cone 1, Trot.
5. Go around Cone 1 to the right and continue around Cone 2 coming across the diagonal towards Cone 4 at a Trot



6. Go around Cone 4 to the left at a Trot continuing passed Cone 3
7. Approaching Cone 2 Canter left and proceed around outside of the cones at a Canter.
8. As coming back to Cone 2, Trot. Proceed to Cone 1 and Halt.
9. Reverse 5 strides.

'Figure 8b' Pattern

(Advanced – requires 35m – 40m wide ring)



1. Halt between the cones
2. Proceed to Canter a 'Figure 8' with simple change through walk
3. Halt between cones 4 seconds
4. Reverse 5 strides
5. Complete a Turn around the Hindquarters 180°
