### **RULES FOR THE AUSTRALIAN TEAMSTER REGISTER**

#### **PURE AUSTRALIAN TEAMSTER DONKEY**

An Australian Teamster Donkey is a donkey which has been captured wild from the bush or descended from 100% Australian bush donkeys

Donkeys in this register must also have permanent identification of fire brand, freeze brand or microchip. And comprise:-

- \* A registered donkey having 100% Australian Teamster bloodlines. Either registered as 100% Australian Teamster Donkey or verifiable as an Australian Teamster Donkey
- Or
- \* Progeny of two registered or verifiable 100% Australian Teamster Donkeys

It must

- \* Stand 11 hh to 14 hh by 5 years of age
- \* Not be broken coloured
- \* Not have any known infusion of other breeds e.g. English/Irish, Mammoth or AMMD blood.

Note:

As the Australian Teamster Donkey Register is a Height as well as a Breed Register, all donkeys in this section must stand 11 hh to 14 hh as well as meeting the blood requirements. This means that if a temporarily registered donkey in this section goes over height it must be transferred to the General Register.

A height certificate validated by an approved Donkey & Mule Society Donkey Measurer must be supplied.
