



## BREED REGISTRATION RULES

# English/Irish Donkey

### OVERVIEW

The English/Irish donkey while compact and small, is strong and sturdy, with an excellent temperament. It is a very active and willing donkey.

### HISTORY

English/Irish donkeys were originally imported from the United Kingdom or Ireland.

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

No donkeys in the English/Irish Register can have any registered Mammoth blood.

Only donkeys with 50% and above registered English/Irish bloodlines will be recorded in this section of the Registry.

Donkeys in the English/Irish Donkey Register may also be entered in the NZ Miniature Donkey Register if their height is 36 inches or under. The % of English/Irish blood will be recorded in the NZ Miniature Donkey Register.

No foals can be registered from sires or dams with temporary registration.

For imported donkeys, the original overseas English/Irish Donkey Registration Certificates must be submitted to the Registrar for verification of pure English/Irish Donkey bloodlines.

## BLOODLINE REQUIREMENTS

### Section A Pure English/Irish Donkey

- A donkey originally imported from the United Kingdom or Ireland and registered in the country of origin

**OR**

- Progeny or descendants of 100% imported registered English/Irish donkeys

#### 100% English/Irish

**OR**

- Progeny or descendants of two English Irish donkeys who are both registered 100% English/Irish with the EIDSA or DMSNZ

**OR**

- Progeny of a registered 100% English/Irish Donkey and a registered 87.5% English/Irish Donkey (EIDSA or DMSNZ)

### Section B Part English/Irish Donkey

#### 87.5% English/Irish

- Progeny of a registered 100% English/Irish Donkey and a registered 75% English/Irish Donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of two registered 87.5% English/Irish Donkeys

#### 75% English/Irish

- Progeny of a registered 100% English/Irish Donkey and a registered 50% English/Irish Donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of a registered 87.5% and a registered 75% English/Irish Donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of two registered 75% English/Irish Donkeys

#### 50% English/Irish

- Progeny of a registered 100% English/Irish Donkey and a registered donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of a registered 87.5% English/Irish Donkey and a registered 50% English/Irish Donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of a registered 75% English/Irish Donkey and a registered 50% English/Irish Donkey

**OR**

- Progeny of two registered 50% English/Irish Donkeys

## ACCREDITATION

English/Irish foals born in New Zealand must be sired by an accredited jack to be eligible for registration as a Pure (Section A) or Part (Section B) English/Irish Donkey.

All English/Irish jacks must be accredited at three years of age.

## PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION

Permanent identification in the form of microchipping is required for registration of an English/Irish Donkey.
